- Open Sheep check-in from 3:00 pm-5:00 pm Sunday, September 25, 2022.
- Open Sheep judging will be at 1:00 pm Tuesday, September 27, 2022 in Barn #1.
- Open Sheep will be released at 10:00 pm Tuesday. **Anyone leaving before 10:00 pm will forfeit prize money.**
- Junior Sheep check-in from 3:00 pm-5:00 pm Sunday, September, 25, 2022.
- Junior Sheep Weigh-in will begin at 6:00 pm-8:00 pm, Monday, September 26, 2022.
- Junior Sheep judging will be at 1:00 pm Tuesday, September 27, 2022.
- Junior Sheep will be released at 10:00 pm Tuesday, September 27, 2022. **Anyone leaving before 10:00 pm will forfeit prize money.**

1. All sheep pre-registries will be due by Friday, September 9, 2022. Entries will be submitted online at www.neadistrictfair.com beginning August 29, 2022.
2. Only bonda fide 4-H and FFA members are eligible to show in the junior division of the Sheep show.
3. All breeding classes of Sheep in both the open and junior division must be registered in the name of the exhibitor.
4. Exhibitors will be limited to two entries per class.
5. All breeding sheep must be registered in their respective association and wear the association ear tag.
6. All breeding sheep must be registered in their respective association and wear the association ear tag. Registration papers must be in possession of exhibitor or a letter from breed association stating that registration is pending.
7. No combination of breeders in filling group classes will be tolerated.
8. Anyone leaving without proper release will forfeit premium money.
9. Junior exhibitors will be given the opportunity to enter their animals in either the Junior or Open department but will not be allowed to show in both.
10. Individuals in lamb classes must be born after September 3, 2021. Yearling may have four teeth.
11. Blankets will be removed after the show unless the animals are to appear in another show within a short period of time, or at the Superintendent's discretion.
12. Sheep will be inspected on grounds. No sheep showing symptoms of disease will be allowed to show.
13. All exhibitor pens must be cleaned out before exiting the fairgrounds. Failure to do so will result in the loss of prize money.
14. Any changes or additional classes will be made at the discretion of the Superintendent.
15. Late entries by permission only + \$10.00 late entry fee.
16. There will be showmanship classes posted based on entries.
17. **ALL PRIZE CHECKS WILL BE VOIDED AFTER 90 DAYS.**
18. The Fair Association is not liable for loss, damage, or injury to any exhibit or animal during the show.
19. **All exhibitor pens must be cleaned out before exiting the fairgrounds. Failure to do so will result in the loss of prize money.**

1. Commercial Breeding Sheep will be defined as sheep not eligible to be registered in a breed association, or which do not have registration papers.
2. Age will be determined by teeth. Yearlings may have four (4) teeth.
3. Commercial Breeding Sheep must abide by the general rules of the fair as well as the rules of the sheep department.
4. No non-registered intact males will be shown.
